TO ENTER

Artists who DO NOT meet the "Automatic Acceptance" status should submit entries in accordance with the following guidelines:

- ◆ Submit up to 5 digital images representative of the work that would be displayed. Clearly label images with your name and media. Burn digital images to a CD, save on a thumbdrive, or e-mail them to lthompson@masoncity.net (1MB or less each).
- ◆ Include a stamped, self-addressed, legal size envelope.
- ◆ **PLEASE NOTE: All entries should be received by MAY 1. The entry fee increases after MAY 1.**

AUTOMATIC ACCEPTANCE

Artists who are currently MacNider Art Museum Shop Artists or were accepted to the Art Market last year should send in the completed entry form with **\$75** fee by MAY 1. The entry fee after MAY 1 increases to **\$90**. **NOTE:** Please add **\$5** for shared booth (2+ artists). No images are required.

ELIGIBLE MEDIA

Original art work, such as paintings, drawings, photography, wheel-thrown or hand-built ceramics, sculpture, fiber, jewelry, leather, printmaking, wood, glass, mixed media, and basketry will be juried.

- ◆ Unacceptable media are: kits, patterns, copy work, pre-molded items, china painting, dough art, poured plaster items, re-sale items, and reproductions.
- ◆ Demonstrations during the market are encouraged.

SPACE RENTAL FEE

A **\$75** fee must be included with the entry form. After MAY 1 the fee increases to **\$90**. **NOTE:** Please add **\$5** for shared booth (2+ artists).

- ◆ If your work is not accepted, the fee will be returned.
- ◆ There is no museum commission on sales.
- ◆ Artists withdrawing from the Art Market after Wednesday, June 1, will forfeit their entry fee.

RULES

Please note: ONLY original artworks may be prominently displayed in the booth. Off-set reproductions may be displayed in bins that take up no more than 10% of booth space and must be clearly identified as reproductions.

- ◆ All work must be designed and executed by the accepted artist.
- ◆ **PLEASE NOTE: Two or more artists may share booth space.** If booth will be shared, all exhibiting artists must include their work for judging and fill out separate entry forms. The entry fee is per booth - artists sharing a booth need only pay one entry fee. **NOTE:** Please add **\$5** for shared booth (2+ artists).
- ◆ Artists, or their representative, must be present with the booth for the entire event.
- ◆ All work shown must be for sale.
- ◆ We reserve the right to ask artists to remove work from their booths that do not meet the Festival's criteria or mission.

SITE SPECIFICATIONS

Site size will be approximately 11' x 11'.

Participating artists need to furnish their own display props.

PLEASE NOTE: This year's Festival will be held outdoors. There will not be an alternate "rain site." Artists should be prepared for inclement weather (example: canopy and warm clothing).
