narrative compositions intended to work both individually and collectively, with emotional vitality and vigorous paint application serving as the means to unite them. He likens painting to theater or opera with light, form and color corresponding to rhythm and tonal chords. Not unlike music, a painting depends upon movement and resolution, and he is always aware of the movement. The relationship between man and woman is often at play, as is the liberation of the creative self.

The artist's goal is to locate all of his work entirely within himself, expressing his own psychology, his own narrative and his own relationship to the culture he inhabits.

Cash awards total \$1,000 along with a one -person exhibition.
