Greetings from the Director!

Thank you to all our members and visitors for another wonderful and successful year!

The Museum has been busier than ever hosting classes, tours, rentals, and visitors. The following pages are just a small snippet into the past year of the MacNider Museum.

In addition to the traditional events the Museum holds each year such as the summer Arts Festival and Holiday Open House, the Museum embarked on a few new adventures. Some were a one-time opportunity due to a traveling exhibition while others were a new addition to the Museum's regular programming.

This year the Museum tried something new by hosting a caregiver and patient class for those with Dementia. This was done in partnership with the exhibition: *Portraits of Dementia*. Those attending the class were given a tour of the exhibition and instructions on how to create a portrait. They were then given materials with which they could make a portrait in a collage fashion. Materials were used that were easy to handle by all participants and those at the class worked together in a collaborative fashion to create each other's portraits. The class taught not only the basics of art but fine motor skill development, color theory, and communication to those attending.

The Museum has done outreach for many years and this year was no exception. In addition to its current roster the Museum participated in Mason City High School and Newman Catholic High School's post-prom event. The event had traditionally focused on athletic activities. The MacNider saw an opportunity to fill a void. Adult coloring books, collage journals, and watercolors were available for the youth to use that evening. It was so successful that students spread out on the floor and extra tables were brought in to accommodate the enthusiastic teens. The Museum was blown away at the overwhelming success of the event. In addition, Lincoln Intermediate requested staff to attend their outdoor field day. Much like post-prom, administrators recognized the need for activities for kids that were not athletic. The Museum helped students make small square paintings that were three dimensional. In all, the Museum had over 100 kids participate in the project.

The Museum continued to host a range of classes that allowed visitors to experience art first hand, as well as exhibitions that brought new art experiences to our community. As always the Museum held its signature events: MacNider Arts Festival, Artoberfest, and Holiday Open House, that are staples of its programming as they continued to engage the community in an arts experience. It continued to provide a quality arts experience with outstanding American Art exhibits for those not only in North Iowa, but for visitors coming from other areas. Most importantly the Museum continued to adapt and nurture programming as the needs of the community it serves changed and grew.

I would like to take this moment to thank the staff of the MacNider Museum: Mara, Belinda, Lindsay, Jackie, Pam, Laura, and Jim work to make the Museum an outstanding gem for the people of Mason City. The success of the Museum is a direct result of the hard work and dedication of the staff of the Museum.

On June 8 families enjoyed nine free “Super MacNider Art

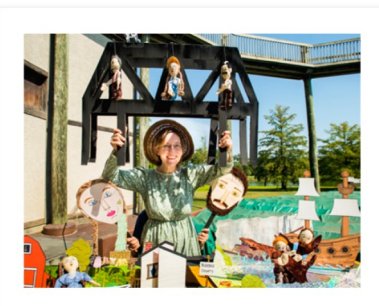

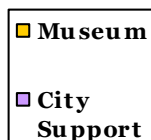
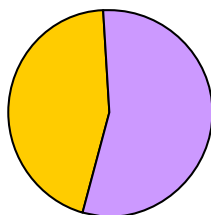
